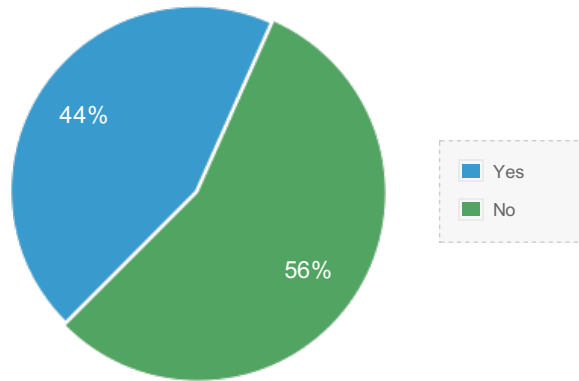

1. Do you use paper toilet seat covers in PUBLIC washrooms if they are available?

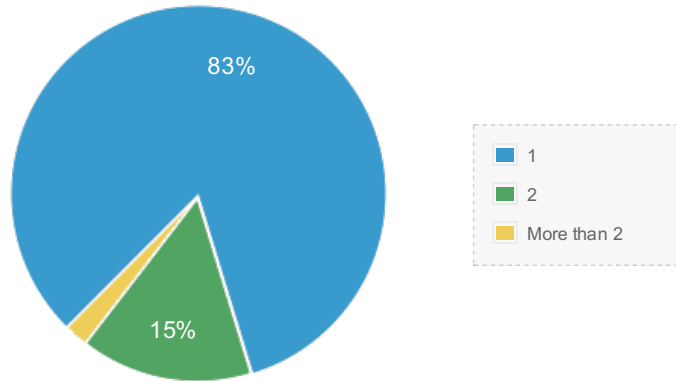

2. How many seat covers do you typically use per visit?

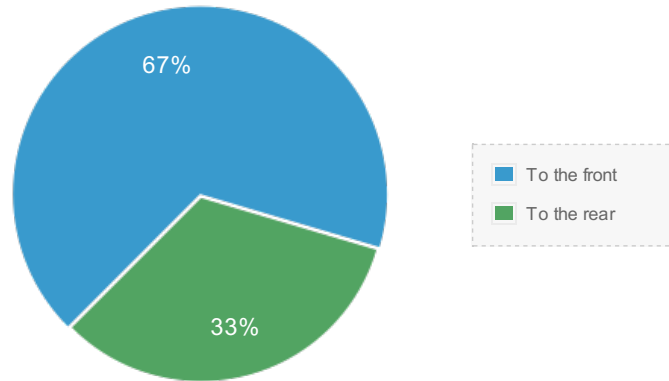

3. How do you position the seat cover / tab / flap?

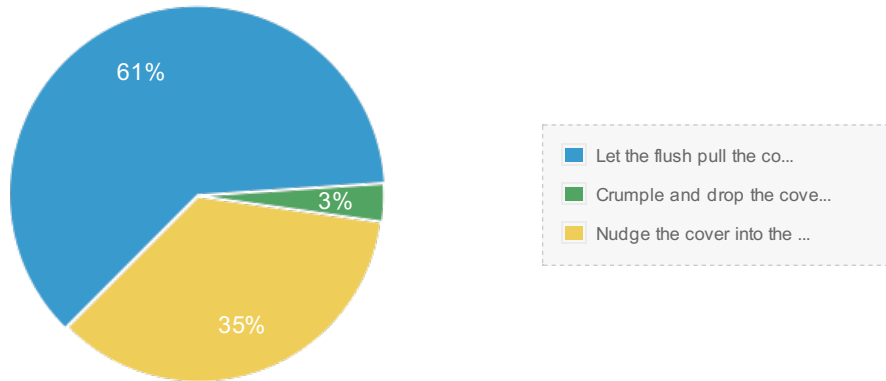

4. How do you flush the seat cover?

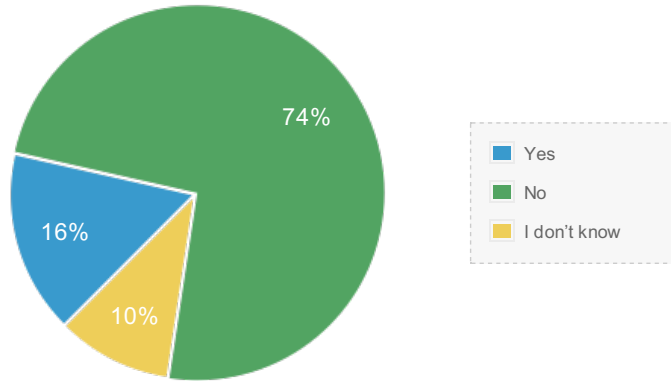
